## **51.19 Cluster Network meeting** update.

Highways have funding for a new road layout and significant road improvements in Antony. The proposal is for a one way system on the Rame peninsula which should help the local flow of traffic and improve safety on A374.

The proposal was agreed by a majority of Councillors.

Consultation to start in Feb 2020.

#### 52.19 Annual Precept 2020/21.

The Forecast Income for 2019/20 is £ 9,607. The Forecast Expenditure is £ 10,970 if the total Solar benefit budget £ 3,704 is spent and the Freathy road markings are completed by 31/3/2020. Given these assumptions £ 5,000 will be carried forward as General reserves for 2020/21.

It was unanimously agreed by the Parish council not to increase the precept.

The precept will be £ 6,000.

The detailed Draft Budget was reviewed.
