- **12.22 Whitsand bay holiday park access road.** Complaints have been received about an access road that has appeared without consultation with Cornwall Council. Cllr Ewert has referred this issue to the Cornwall Council Enforcement planning team.
- **13.22 Website regulations and gov.uk email addresses**. The Auditor suggested that St John PC members should use a gov.uk domain for correspondence. Members to review in due course.
- **14.22 Members discussed the Beer and bus tour** proposed in June. Concerns had been raised by a parishioner that the bus would cause parking issues in the village if a large bus required a turning space at the St John Inn. It appears from the itinerary this is not an issue. **Action:** Clerk to contact Cllr Ewert for advice.
- **15.22 Tree management in St John.** The members discussed the ongoing issues of potentially dangerous trees in St John. **Action:** Cllr Tanner to draft a response for the clerk to send to CC and Cllr Ewert.
